LB 754

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Erdman. Senator Kremer, on the Chambers amendment.

SENATOR KREMER: Question. Question.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The question has been called. Do I see five hands? I do. The question before the body is, shall debate cease on FA1344? All in favor vote aye, and opposed nay. We're voting on ceasing debate on the Chambers amendment, FA1344, to LB 754. Have you all voted who care to? Voting on ceasing debate. Have you all voted who care to? Motion before the body is to cease debate on amendment FA1344. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, to cease debate.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Debate does cease. Senator Chamber, you're recognized to close on your amendment, FA1344.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, as I told Senator Wehrbein, I'm going to pull this amendment. I don't see him on the floor now. I was going to answer some of those weighty questions that he asked, but I will wait till he returns before I do that. And at this juncture, I want to withdraw that pending amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn, Senator Chambers. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Beutler would move to amend, FA1345. (Legislative Journal page 1590.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, you're recon...I mean, Senator Beutler, you're recognized to open on FA1345 to LB 754. Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Cudaback, members of the Legislature, as I indicated to you previously, we discussed the fact that there were three parts to the bill. One part of the bill has to do with the Department of Ag going out and interacting with the
