SENATOR CHAMBERS: Roll call vote.

SPEAKER BROMM: All in favor please vote aye, and opposed nay. A roll call vote has been requested. Mr. Clerk, we'll proceed to call the roll. Excuse me, Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: Once the roll call vote is done, we couldn't do a call of the house, as I recall, so if we're going to do this, let's have a call of the house now.

SPEAKER BROMM: A call of the house has been requested. All in favor of the house going under call please vote aye, and opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays to place the house under call.

SPEAKER BROMM: The house is under call. Members, please return to your seats and record your presence. Unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. The house is under call. Senator Brashear, Senator Brown. Senator Erdman. Senator Brown. Senator Landis indicating it's...we may proceed to vote. The Clerk would please call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal pages 1631-1632.) 24 ayes, 19 nays on the committee amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: The committee amendments are not adopted. Next item on the bill, Mister...I'll raise the call. Mr. Clerk, do you have any messages or announcements?

CLERK: I do, Mr. President, thank you. A bill read on Final Reading this morning was presented to the Governor at 9:35 (re LB 282). New A bill. (Read LP 759A by title for the first time, Legislative Journal page 1632.)

Mr President, the next amendment I have to LB 283 is by Senator Landis, AM1713.
