LB 410, 415, 424

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion is to advance LB 410 to E & R for engrossing. All in favor of that motion say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: LB 415. Senator Mossey, I have no amendments to the bill.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Mossey, for a motion.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 415 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the motion to advance LB 415 to E & R for engrossing. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced.

CLERK: LB 424, Mr. President. Senator Mossey, I do have Enrollment and Review amendments. (AM7122, Legislative Journal page 1603.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Mossey, for a motion

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. President, I move the adoption of E & R amendments to LB 424.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion is to adopt E & R amendments. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: Senator Beutler has an amendment to the bill. (AM1656, Legislative Journal page 1826.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Beutler, you're recognized to open on your amendment.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Good morning. (Laughter) Select File always has that sense of rapidity to it that stirs me up a little bit and tires me out. This is an amendment to a bill, where basically the Appropriations Committee...and I was a part of it...stole an idea from Pam Brown, Senator Brown.
