says...talks about a report from each institution to the Coordinating Commission, and it says, the report shall include an accounting of all institutionally funded student financial aid. We've changed that to state funded or federally funded student financial aid. For private and independent colleges, really the only thing that's of interest is state funded or federally funded financial aid. So again, this is something that is agreed upon by the important players in the process, that would make the process work better. So I would be happy to address questions, but ask your support. Thank you.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Raikes. You've heard the opening on AM1923. Is there any discussion? Seeing none, Senator Raikes...waives closing. The question then is the adoption of AM1923. All in favor vote aye, and opposed nay. Please record.
