SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Smith. You've heard the opening on confirmation report. Open for discussion on that motion. No discussion. Senator Smith, did you wish to close? He waives the opportunity to close. The question before the body is adoption of the confirmation report offered by the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. You're voting on the confirmation report offered by the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee. Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote, Legislative Journal page 1876.) 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the confirmation report.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful and it has been adopted. We now move to the next agenda item, Select File, 2003 senator priority bills. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 754, first bill for consideration. Senator Mossey, I have Enrollment and Review amendments, first of all.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Mossey for a motion.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 754.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments. All in favor of that motion say aye. Opposed nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first amendment this morning is Senator Chambers, I believe...I'm sorry, Senator McDonald. Senator, you had pending a motion to recommit the bill to committee, but I have a note that you'd like to withdraw that.
