said, he's not any more surprised than I am. Because it was something that I had just wanted to do, did, and won. We need to take a look at civility, and not say, we got you, we did this, we did that, whether it be on our side or the constituents' side. I don't like to see anybody not get their way. And boy, we're seeing that a lot this year. In my own street, I have somebody very, very mad that I would support any taxes. I also have somebody very, very mad that I would support any cuts to schools. We were sent here to make them decisions and to put up with that heat. And if you can't stand the heat in the kitchen, get out. Some have. That part doesn't worry me, about what the people who are adamantly against this are saying, because I have found far more people that are for it. And I think that's in any issue. And if that's not true, then when you're in the ballot box, then they have a choice to pick somebody else. And we'll go about our lives. It wasn't too long ago here that we had...we had a reunion of former senators. And none of them looked any worse off when they left here,...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR Dw. PEDERSEN: ...or, since they left here, than they were when they were here. I'm not here to protect the job. But I do believe that we need to protect the position, for the sake of our people and our children to come. Thank you.
