LB 467, 536

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Janssen. Open for discussion on the committee amendment offered by the General Affairs Committee. Seeing no lights on, Senator Janssen, do you wish to close? He waives the opportunity to close. Question before the body is adoption of AM0740, offered by the General Affairs. All in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on adoption of the General Affairs Committee amendment, AM0740. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of committee amendments.

SENATOR CUDABACK: They are adopted. Back to discussion of the bill itself, LB 536. No lights on. Senator Hudkins, did you wish to close on the advancement of LB 536? She waives the opportunity. The question before the body is adoption...or, the movement of LB 536. All in favor of the motion to advance to E & R Initial vote aye, those opposed nay. Have you all voted who care to? We're voting on advancement of LB 536. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 536.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 536 does advance. Mr. Clerk, next agenda item.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 467 is a bill by Senator Jensen. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 16 of this year, referred to Health and Human Services for public hearing. The bill was advanced to General File. I do have committee amendments, Mr. President. (AM0479, Legislative Journal page 631.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Jensen, you're recognized to open on advancement of LB 467.

SENATOR JENSEN: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the Legislature. LB 467 is the second priority bill of the Health and Human Services Committee. The bill could be characterized
