SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Erdman, for a motion.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 643.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 643. All in favor of that motion say aye. Opposed nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further to the bill, Senator.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Erdman, for a motion.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 643 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Heard the motion to advance LB 643 to E & R for engrossing. All in favor of the motion say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced. Thank you, Senator Erdman. It is ten o'clock, almost. Next agenda item, Select File, 2003 committee priority bills. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 608. The bill was discussed on May 19. Enrollment and Review amendments were adopted at that time. The bill was eventually bracketed that day. When the Legislature left the issue, Senator Bromm had pending AM2005, and Senator Smith had pending to the Bromm amendment AM2006.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Bromm, would you like to update us on where we stand, since it's been awhile since we've been to LB 608? Senator Bromm? Is Senator Bromm available? Senator Bromm? Senator Bromm, would you like to update us? We are now on LB 608.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Mr. President. Sorry for the delay. LB 608, we were on my amendment, which basically proposed to eliminate the provisions of LB 608 that had been adopted previously, substitute what has been referred to as a rural tier economic development amendment for the LB 270 program that has
