see no further persons wishing to discuss your amendment. Do you wish to close on your amendment?

SENATOR LANDIS: I'd be grateful for your support on this. It is kind of jumping horses in the middle of the stream to file it to this, but I think we probably have a lot of talk on LB 283 coming, and that's got an uncertain future. This is good policy. It's really just supporting policy that came out of the discussions inside the Revenue Committee last year, and this is the right vehicle to do it. It does not have the same troubled future that LB 283 does, so I'd ask that we adopt it to LB 572. Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Landis. You've heard the closing on AM2098. All in favor of the amendment vote aye, and opposed nay. Please record.
