SENATOR CUDABACK: There's been a request for a call of the house. All in favor of the house going under call vote aye, opposed nay. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK 36 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to place the house under call.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The house is under call. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Unexcused senators report to the Chamber. The house is under call. Senator Byars, please check in. Thank you. Senator Combs, would you check in, please? Senator Synowiecki. Senator Bourne, would you check in, please? Thank you.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Mr. President,...

SENATOR CUDABACK: You...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...I would be willing to close while we're gathering, if it's all right.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You may do so.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I just...I'll be very brief. I want to thank Senator Jensen for the comments that he made and the handout he has. Obviously, there's lots of work to do yet. And there are several study resolutions in his committee, our committee, Education Committee, and some other things, continuing to look at the structure. I would urge you to over...vote to override. I also want to go on record, say I'll vote to override on the other two bills, LB 759 and LB 540. I urge you to strongly consider. This is a package of the work that we're doing, based on Appropriations, Revenue, Education, and all the rest of you that are involved in different areas. This is harvest, if you will. And that's it.
