ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read title of LB 790.)

SPEAKER BROMM: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 790 pass with the emergency clause attached, Senator Landis' bill? All in favor vote aye, and opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal pages 2126-2127.) Vote is 45 ayes, 1 nay, 2 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: LB 790E does pass with the emergency clause attached. LB 790A.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 790A on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BROMM: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 790A pass with the emergency clause attached? All in favor vote aye, and opposed nay. Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 2127.) Vote is 47 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: LB 790A does pass with the emergency clause attached. That will conclude Final Reading. The call is raised. Members, the next item of business will be a series of legislative resolutions that we'll consider as a group. I will call upon the individual introducers, if they wish to make any comments, and of course then open for general discussion after that. Before proceeding to discussion on the resolutions, I...and while the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do sign LB 720, LB 790, and LB 790A. Mr. Clerk. Begin with LR 189.
