ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, new bills. (Read LB 939-955 by title for the first time, Legislative Journal pages 165-168.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We will now stand at ease while new bills are introduced. Mr. Clerk.
