LB 811.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 811 does advance. Mr. Clerk, next bill.

CLERK: LB 812 is a bill by Senator Engel, as Chair of the Executive Board. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 7, referred directly to General File.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Engel, to open.

SENATOR ENGEL: Mr. Speaker, members, this bill simply eliminates an inconsistency in Chapter 60.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Any discussion on advancement of LB 812, E & R Initial? Seeing no lights on, Senator Engel. He waives the opportunity to close. The question before the body is advancement of LB 812 to E & R Initial. All in favor of advancement vote aye, those opposed nay. Have you all voted who wish to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 812.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 812 does advance. Mr. Clerk, next bill, when you get time.

CLERK: LB 813, by Senator Engel, as Chair of the board. (Read title.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Engel, to open on LB 813.

SENATOR ENGEL: Mr. Speaker, members, this bill would change many sections where there are forms that still have "19" as the first part of the date. This bill will update the form for those who use them.
