Senator Brashear, Senator Redfield, Senator Quandahl, and Senator Bourne. Senator Redfield, the house is under call. Would you report to the Chamber, please; Quandahl as well, and Senator Bourne? Senator Brashear. Senator Redfield, the house is under call. Report to the Chamber, please. Senator Chambers, we're trying to find Senator Redfield. I got the message. Would you check in, please, Senator Brashear? Thank you very much. Senator Redfield, the house is under call. Would you please check in? Senator. Thank you very much. The question before the body is adoption of FALL67, offered by Senator Chambers to LR 4CA. There's been a request for a roll call vote. Mr. Clerk, call the roll on the question, please.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal page 251.)  
2 ayes, 23 nays on the amendment, Mr. President.
