SENATOR CHAMBERS: (Laugh) Thank you. And, Senator Raikes, if you had scheduled one of my bills for hearing it would show total incompetency because I have no education bills that went to your committee, so you won that one.

SENATOR RAIKES: Thank you.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: You are quick.

SENATOR RAIKES: Thank you for recognizing that.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Any further discussion on the rule suspension? Senator Raikes, did you wish to close? There are no further lights on. He waives the opportunity to close. Mr. Clerk, read the motion, please.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Raikes would move to suspend Rule 3, Section 13, to permit cancelation of the public hearing on LB 917 set for next Tuesday.

SENATOR CUDABACK: All in favor of such motion vote aye, opposed nay. And this does require 30 votes. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to suspend the rules to permit cancelation of the hearing.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. Mr. Clerk, items?

CLERK: Mr. President, pursuant to that action, I have notice of cancelation of hearing, offered by the Education Committee, with respect to LB 917. Mr. President, LB...I have notice of hearings from the Business and Labor Committee, from the General Affairs Committee, from the Agriculture Committee. Mr. President, new bills. (Read LB 1109-1118 by title for the first time.) Mr. President, a new constitutional amendment, LR 222CA, offered by Senator Quandahl. It proposes an amendment to Article III, Section 7, of the Nebraska Constitution.

Mr. President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports they've examined and reviewed LB 172 and recommend that same be
