SENATOR CUDABACK: There has been a request for a call of the house. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 17 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, to place the house under call.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The house is under call. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Unexcused senators report to the Chamber. The house is under call. Senator Dwite Pedersen, check in, please. Senator Landis, please. Senator Burling, Senator Wehrbein, Senator Quandahl, Senator Chambers, would you check in, please? Senator Synowiecki, please, and Senator Beutler and Senator Bourne, please check in. Senator Quandahl and Senator Burling. Senator Bourne. Senator Quandahl. Senator Quandahl and...Senator Quandahl. Senator Price has authorized call-in votes. All members present or accounted for. Mr. Clerk, we're authorized call-in votes.

CLERK: Senator Mossey voting yes. Senator Bourne voting yes. Senator Aguilar voting yes. Senator Cunningham voting yes. Senator Beutler voting yes. Senator Bromm voting yes.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 37.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 37 does advance. I do raise the call.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next bill, LB 37A by Senator Price. (Read title.)
