PRESIDENT HEINEMAN PRESIDING

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Good morning. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber for the ninth day of the Ninety-Eighth Legislature, Second Session. Our chaplain for today is Pastor Dan Inman, Plains Baptist Church from Lincoln, Nebraska, Senator Beutler's district. Please rise.
