SENATOR BAKER: I would ask for a call of the house, please?

SPEAKER BROMM: A call of the house has been requested. All in favor of the house going under call please vote aye, and opposed nay. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to place the house under call.

SPEAKER BROMM: The house is under call. All senators who are not excused please report to the Chamber and record your presence. Unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. The house is under call. Senators Brown, Landis. Maxwell, Synowiecki. Senator Beutler, would you check in please? Senator Landis. Senator Brown, would you check in please? Senator Baker, waiting on Senator Landis. Do you wish to wait? Would you say that again please, Senator Baker?

SENATOR BAKER: Roll call vote in reverse order, please. And we can proceed.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Baker has agreed to proceed without Senator Landis here, and he's requested a roll call vote in reverse order. Mr. Clerk. All in favor of AM2150 vote aye, and opposed nay. Mr. Clerk will call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal page 325.)
22 ayes, 13 nays, Mr. President, on the amendment.

SPEAKER BROMM: The amendment is not adopted. Before proceeding further, I would like to...and then I'll raise the call.
