SENATOR CUDABACK: Your time is up, Senator Johnson.

SENATOR JOHNSON: ...both embryo and adult stem cell research.
Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Johnson. I'd like to remind the body today is day ten. There is a few minutes left to introduce new bills. If you have any on your desks, this will be it. Mr. Clerk, items for the record, or new bills.

CLERK: Mr. President, new bills. (Read LB 1251-1255 by title for the first time.) Mr. President, in addition to those items, I have new constitutional amendment resolutions: LR 224CA, by Senator Landis, proposing amendment to Article VIII, Section 1; LR 225CA, by Senator Brashear, proposing amendment to Article VII, Section 13; LR 226, by Senator Quandahl, memorializes Congress to prepare and submit to the several states an amendment to the Constitution of the United States; LR 227CA, by Senator Maxwell, proposes an amendment to Article III, Sections 7 and 19, of the Nebraska Constitution; LR 228CA, by Senator Maxwell, proposes an amendment to Article VIII, Section 1A of the Nebraska Constitution. Mr. President, the...in addition to those items, amendments to be printed: Senator Hartnett to LB 644; Senator Synowiecki, LB 278; Senator Quandahl, LB 227; Senator Smith, LB 602. I have confirmation reports from the Agriculture Committee and the Nebraska Retirement Systems Committee. Your Committee on Transportation, chaired by Senator Baker, reports LB 908 to General File. And Retirement Systems Committee, chaired by Senator Stuhr, reports LB 961 to General File. Hearing notices from Revenue and Judiciary. And a series of name adds, Mr. President: Senator Quandahl to LB 870; Senator Synowiecki to LB 316; Senator Tyson, LB 850; Senator Tyson to LB 1046; Senator Brown, LB 1046; Senator Foley, LB 1136; Senator Vrtiska, LB 1149; Senator Mossey, LB 1176; and Senator Cudaback to withdraw his name from LB 914.
