FLOOR DEBATE

January 22, 2004 LB 602

**SPEAKER BROMM:** A call of the house has been requested. All in favor of the house going under call please vote aye, and opposed nay. Please record.

**CLERK:** 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to place the house under call.

**SPEAKER BROMM:** The house is under call. Members, please check in, and all members who are not excused please return to the Chamber and record your presence. Unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. The house is under call. Senator Smith, for what purpose do you rise?

**SENATOR SMITH:** I'd ask for a roll call vote in regular order, please.

**SPEAKER BROMM:** Senator Smith has requested a roll call vote in regular order. Senator Schrock and Senator Landis, Senator Preister and Senator Connealy. Senator Schrock, Landis, and Preister, please return to the Chamber. Senator Preister. Senator Smith.

**SENATOR SMITH:** Mr. Speaker, could you outline what exactly will take...will take place following a successful cloture vote.

**SPEAKER BROMM:** I will, Senator Smith. I'll wait till Senator Preister arrives.

**SENATOR SMITH:** Okay. Thank you.

**SPEAKER BROMM:** All members are present. Before proceeding to vote on the motion for cloture, let me remind the members of the process. The first vote will be a vote for cloture. If that vote is successful, which does require 33 votes, we'll then proceed to vote on Senator Chambers' motion to reconsider the recommit to committee motion that he has and, depending on the outcome of that motion, we would then proceed to vote on the pending amendment, which would be the committee amendment, AM0971, and then we would proceed to vote on the advancement of LB 602 to Select File. With that, we'll proceed to vote on the cloture motion and, Mr. Clerk, the request was for a roll call
