32 ayes, 12 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to invoke
cloture.

with the rule. And, Mr. Clerk, do you have items for the

as correctly engrossed. Your Committee on Revenue reports

reports LB 560, LB 560A, LB 740, LB 644, LB 236, LB 75, LB 155,
all to Select File. In addition to those items, Mr. President,
Senator Bourne would like to withdraw LB 1129. That will be
laid over. I have amendments to be printed: Senator Burling,
an amendment to LB 1083. And priority bill designations:
Senator Jones, LB 1086; and Senator Kremer, LB 1103. I believe
