ASSISTANT CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal page 397.) Vote is 16 ayes, 24 nays on the motion to reconsider, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion to reconsider was not successful. I do raise the call. Mr. Clerk, do you have any items for the record, messages, or announcements?

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, I do. Your Committee on Urban Affairs reports LB 842 advanced to General File, LB 937 advanced to General File with amendments, LB 997 with amendments, LB 1007 with amendments, LB 1008 with amendments. Committee on Revenue reports LB 984 to General File with amendments, LB 854 as indefinitely postponed, LB 857 indefinitely postponed. Priority bill designations, Mr. President: LB 1097 by the Retirement Committee; LB 1128 by Senator Hudkins. I have a Reference Committee report rereferring LB 1185 and LB 1186, as well as certain gubernatorial appointments. Notice of committee hearings from General Affairs, Retirement Systems. Amendments to be printed to LB 762, offered by Senator Beutler; Senator Johnson to LB 139. In addition, a series of name adds: LB 834 by Senator Aguilar, LB 858 by Senator Aguilar, and LB 963 by Senator Aguilar; LB 1190 by Senator Janssen; LB 1190 by Senator Combs, Kremer, and Stuhr.
