CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 449.)  
44 ayes, 0 nays, 5 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: LB 811 does pass. LB 812, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read LB 812 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BROMM: All provisions of law relative to procedure  
having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 812 pass?  
All in favor vote aye, and opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: (Record vote read. Legislative Journal page 450.)  
44 ayes, 0 nays, 5 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: LB 812 does pass. We will now go to LB 813,  
and the first vote is to dispense with the at-large reading.  
All those in favor of dispensing with the at-large reading of  
LB 813 please vote aye, and opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 40 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, to dispense with the  
at-large reading.

SPEAKER BROMM: The at-large reading is dispensed with.  
Mr. Clerk, please read LB 813 by title.

CLERK: (Read title of LB 813.)

SPEAKER BROMM: All provisions of law relative to procedure  
having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 813 pass?
