SENATOR CUDABACK PRESIDING

SENATOR CUDABACK: Good morning. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain of the day this morning is the Reverend Daniel Seiker, chaplain for the School Sisters of Christ the King, in Senator Byars' district. Chaplain.
