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FLOOR DEBATE

February 6, 2004 LB 353, 560

SENATOR VRTISKA: Yes. Thank you very much. I appreciate your vote. Again, I think I pretty well explained what this bill will do, what effect it will have if you would agree to vote in the affirmative on this piece of legislation, because it only cleans up a section that certainly needed some attention. And that's what this bill would do. It's basically...I explained to...explained it somewhat in the amendment phase of the bill. So I would hope that I...you would get my...you would give me your support. Thank you.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Thank you, Senator Vrtiska. Senator Mossey.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 353 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: All in favor say aye. Opposed. The bill is advanced. Mr. Clerk, next bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next bill is LB 560. Senator Mossey, I do have Enrollment and Review amendments, Senator. (AM7159, Legislative Journal page 373.)

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Senator Mossey.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. President, I move the adoption of E & R amendments to LB 560.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: You've heard the motion. All in favor say aye. Opposed. Motion carried.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Baker would move to amend, AM2370. (Legislative Journal page 467.)

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Senator Baker.

SENATOR BAKER: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein and members. AM2370 does as Senator Bourne had asked for us to do, and that extends the 10-day period which a person is allowed to 90 (sic) days to furnish title. He pointed out that a lot of titles are held outside the state. It takes awhile to get them back. That's on page 42, line 4. And I need to mention that the E & R
