we've combined into AM2490 is LB 861. It also was heard in the Transportation Committee, advanced. And it is a bill that requires the return of registration certificates and license plates to the Department of Motor Vehicles for in-state motor carriers. Now, when the federal motor carrier safety people revoke somebody's license, it's an apportioned license, and so on. But if they're based in Nebraska, then Nebraska needs the ability to go to that carrier and say, your license has been revoked on the federal level, and this enables them to go actually obtain...get a return of that registration certificate and their license plates. It's a Department of Motor Vehicles bill. It's enacting...it's a method for them to enact the regulations that are imposed upon us when a federal--we're talking an in-the-state, intrastate carrier has their license revoked by the federal agency. That is the two bills that we have amended into LB 560, in the form of AM2490. I would be glad to answer any questions.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Thank you, Senator Baker. There are no lights. Do you wish to close?

SENATOR BAKER: Well, very briefly, I guess. If anyone would have any questions, these are bills that we simply need to get passed this session, enabling language for issues--in one issue, the federal regulations; and the second one is the cleanup, if you will, the language that we implemented in Senator Burling's bill dealing with titling ATVs. And I would ask for the adoption of AM2490. Thank you.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Thank you, Senator Baker. We will now be voting on the amendment AM2490. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Baker's amendment.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.
