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SENATOR JONES: You've got to pay the tax and all the registration clear back to January anyway. The only thing this does is add this 14 percent just on the tax.

SENATOR STUTHMAN: So it does add interest onto the taxes portion of it?

SENATOR JONES: That's all. And that goes into the general fund at the county level.

SENATOR STUTHMAN: Okay. I think I understand what you're trying to do. You're trying to get interest on the taxes that are due...

SENATOR JONES: Right.

SENATOR STUTHMAN: ...with this.

SENATOR JONES: Right. Just the same as your real estate. If I go in the 2nd of May to pay the first half, I've got to pay 14 percent on them two days.

SENATOR STUTHMAN: So in other words, it would be better for me just to license it in January and be done with it, instead of paying that 14 percent interest, then?

SENATOR JONES: That's right. That's right. (Laugh)

SENATOR STUTHMAN: Okay. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Stuthman. Senator Engel, on the Jones amendment to the Wehrbein amendment.

SENATOR ENGEL: Mr. President, members of the body, I just have a quick question for Senator Jones.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Jones.

SENATOR ENGEL: Some of these cars...if you would respond?

SENATOR JONES: Yes, I will.
