this regulation and licensure would fall under the Nebraska Cosmetology Act. As we have been discussing this morning, there are a few items that we do need to address and I will be very willing to work with anyone that has an interest, particularly Senator Bourne and Senator Chambers, on these issues, and we will bring them in an amendment and have an amendment ready for Select File. But there has been much support for this bill. I think this bill is actually overdue. We have support from the State Board of Health, as I mentioned before, the Nebraska Medical Association, Dental Association, law enforcement officers, and particularly many parents and also practitioners who have been concerned. So my main concern in this bill is the health and safety of the public, and I'm asking for your support. Thank you.

SENATOR STUHR: Go ahead.
