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there are representatives of the Department of Motor Vehicles outside the glass who are here to answer any questions that you may have, if you want to discuss that particular aspect with them. There is also...will follow, if this is amended on and LB 559 advances, a one-time cost that is borne by the cash fund of the Department of Motor Vehicles. And that is...its purpose is to be able to change some of the documents that are presented, and also to change the software programs. And that amount--I believe I had it in front of me two minutes ago, but I don't have it right now--I think it's \$18,400. That is a one-time expenditure from the cash fund to be able to set up the program and get it ready to go. So with that, Senator Bourne, if you...do you have any more questions, or is there anything else I can...?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Bourne.

SENATOR BOURNE: Thank you, Senator Thompson. I'll be honest with you. I like your amendment better than the entire bill. And so I just wanted some clarity as to whether or not this information was going to be safeguarded, that the information that's going to be transferred to the federally designated organ procurement organization. And what you're telling us is that the committee that's going to be set up, you're confident that there will be protection measures that this information is dealt with in a proper manner.
