SENATOR SCHIMEK: I...yes, I assume so. I think what...I think the point that you're raising, Senator Chambers, is that this particular paragraph, this particular introductory to the section is very...it's difficult to read for its real meaning, and I think if there's any place that we might look, it's at that particular paragraph. Because it almost sounds like you're adopting the whole thing.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: And I don't...but that's not what we're trying...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: ...to do here.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schimek. Mr. Clerk, items for the record?

CLERK: Mr. President, I do. A confirmation report from the Natural Resources Committee. That's signed by Senator Schrock, as Chair. Revenue Committee reports LB 1219 to General File with amendments, and LB 1066 indefinitely postponed. Natural Resources Committee reports LB 833 to General File. Health and Human Services reports LB 931 to General File; LB 594, General File with amendments; LB 1084, LB 1158, LB 1159, all to General File with amendments; and LB 1226 indefinitely postponed; those reports signed by Senator Jensen. Enrollment and Review reports LB 906A to Select File. Enrollment and Review also reports LB 227, LB 323, LB 449, LB 449A, LB 559, LB 559A as correctly engrossed.
