Senator Beutler to the committee amendments to LB 999. All in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on the Beutler amendment to the committee amendments. The question before the body is the Beutler amendment, FA1470, to the committee amendments to LB 999. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the Beutler amendment to the committee amendments.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. The Beutler amendment has been adopted. Mr. Clerk, anything further on the committee amendments?

CLERK: Nothing further on the committee amendments, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Seeing no further discussion, Senator Quandahl, Chairman of the committee, you're recognized to close on the committee amendments to LB 999.

SENATOR QUANDAHL: Thank you, Mr. President. And I also thank Senator Beutler and the members of the body for bearing with us in getting through the committee amendments, and also LB 999. Just in summary, the committee amendments incorporate some provisions of the Uniform Trust Code study committee that was a bill, LB 885, and then also another bill, LB 979, which makes some minor adjustments to laws concerning banking and finance in the state of Nebraska. I do believe that in balance that these would enhance the position of the consumer, of the citizens of the state of Nebraska. And so I would urge the adoption of AM2339 to LB 999.
