CLERK: 27 ayes, 11 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Louden's amendment.

SPEAKER BROMM: The amendment is adopted. The next vote will be whether LB 1049 shall advance to Select File. All in favor of advancing LB 1049 please vote aye, and opposed nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 8 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 1049.

SPEAKER BROMM: LB 1049 does advance. I raise the call. While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do sign the following legislative bills: LB 236, LB 382, LB 740, LB 208, LB 353, LB 227, LB 270. And while we are in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and also sign LR 239, LR 238. (Legislative Journal page 778.)

Mr. Clerk, do you have any announcements?

CLERK: I do, Mr. President. Mr. President, LR 246, a new resolution by Senator Erdman. That will be laid over. New A bill, LB 1019A, by Senator Landis. (Read LB 1019A by title for the first time.) Mr. President, your Committee on General Affairs reports LB 538 and LB 787 as indefinitely postponed. Health Committee reports LB 1145 to General File with committee amendments attached. And I have an amendment by Senator Landis to LR 209 to be printed. And amendments from Senator Chambers to LB 998 to be printed. Senator Redfield would like to add her name to LB 1083 as cointroducer. And Mr. President, that's all that I have, other than a priority motion. (Legislative Journal pages 778-780.)

SPEAKER BROMM: (Visitors introduced.) Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Redfield would move to adjourn until Thursday morning, February 26, at 9:00 a.m.
