PRESIDENT HEINEMAN PRESIDING

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Good morning. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber for the thirty-third day of the Ninety-Eighth Legislature, Second Session. Our pastor for today is Pastor Del Wiemers of the Saint John's Lutheran Church, Beatrice, Nebraska, Senator Byars' district. Please rise.
