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I had better do, and that I'd better do it well, not just well, but better than anybody else. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator McDonald, on the Chambers amendment to the committee amendments.

SENATOR McDONALD: Yes. Mr. President and members of the body, I'd like to yield my time to Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, you have almost five minutes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Senator McDonald. Members of the Legislature, I have to ask Senator Don Pederson another question about his bill, before I lose track of what I want to do with reference to this bill.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Pederson, would you yield to a question from Senator Chambers?

SENATOR D. PEDERSON: I shall. Thank you.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Don Pederson, was this bill brought to you by somebody? And that's not a pejorative question.

SENATOR D. PEDERSON: Well, this bill is a follow-up to my bill of last year. And I have discussed this at times with members of the medical profession and their representatives, to...who are very concerned about the viability of the fund. And that's why it came about.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So there is no opposition from the individuals who will have to pay a greater amount of money when we pass this bill. Is that crystal clear?

SENATOR D. PEDERSON: That's what I understand.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. And that's all I would...

SENATOR D. PEDERSON: Thank you.
