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have something that is consistent, coherent, and rational. After I offer those kinds of amendments, if I think a substantive change has to be made to the bill, I'm going to offer it, because nobody outside the Legislature controls me. I understand what Senator Schrock said, but whether they voted on anything or not, I'm a member of the Legislature. They don't vote for me and they don't dictate to me. The bill is not so important to me that I'm going to relinquish my prerogatives as a legislator. Those people on that task force should have been told that there's a senator in there named Ernie Chambers who is not going to go our way just because we say 49 of us in the rural area said do it this way, so he ought to do it because we told him to. If anything, that's going to make him look with a jaundiced eye on it. That is not a reason for us to adopt this committee amendment, which includes other bills. When we come back, after the noon hour, there will be divisions made of this committee amendment, and some of the divisions will comprise individual bills. Those should not be as difficult to discuss because they'll be discrete little inlays. But when we get to the part of the bill itself, where you don't have those additions,...

SENATOR JANSSEN: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...and there are interrelationships, we're going to have to go maybe from page 1 to page 63, line 14, or something like that, if we're going to look at it the way I want to look at it and have it explained to me. But if something is not clear to me, I'm not going to swallow it and say, well, I don't know what it means but there are smarter people who do know. Uh-uh. If they're smart, they're able to explain it so that I can understand, if they want my vote. If they tell me, Ernie, you can take your vote and shove it, I'd say, well, I can do more than that. I can make sure nobody votes, and we'll take your bill and tell you to shove it. And more than that, we can tell you where to take it and what you can use it for when you're there. So those people who think they got some power over this Legislature and have to work with the Legislature, they need to understand a little bit more about me. This isn't directed to Senator Schrock, but he's just the messenger who gave us that notion that there's a delicate balance here, and I
