embarrassing to Senator Friend, not because it's bad, but he had never noticed it before. But I have the eye of a fly, meaning it's microscopic in a way. But when the time comes to reveal this, I shall, and everybody is going to say, my God, Ernie is right again. But I think I'll let you sit in suspense until that time. Mr. President, since Senator Friend agrees with the amendment, can this be my closing?

SENATOR CUDABACK: There are no lights on so it may be.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Then I'm through, thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. You've heard the question on FA1542. The question before the body is adoption of FA1542. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. The question before the body is the Chambers amendment FA1542 which is an amendment to LB 888. Have you all voted on the amendment who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Chambers' amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. FA1542 has been adopted. Mr. Clerk, next amendment.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Chambers would move to amend with FA1543. (Legislative Journal page 947.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, to open on FA1543.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Mr. President and members of the Legislature. This is probably the simplest amendment that I've offered. This that I'm amending would go back to the previous page where it is talking about the State Energy Office producing manuals which are to be used by architects, engineers, prime contractors, and owners. Then when we get to page 8 where I am, in line 1 I would strike "The" and in line 2 I would strike "The." In each case, that word appears before "manuals" and I would replace each of the "Thes" with the word "Such" to make it clear we're referring back to the manuals that had been mentioned previously. That's all that the amendment does.
