SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Baker. You've heard the closing on advancement. The question is, before the body, shall LB 997 advance to E & R Initial? All in favor vote aye and opposed nay. The question before the body is the advancement of LB 997. Have you all voted who care to, advancement of LB 997? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance the bill.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 997 advances. Mr. Clerk, do you have any items for the record, or announcements?

ASSISTANT CLERK: Thank you, Mr. President. I do. I have a series of confirmation reports from your Judiciary Committee. In addition to that, Judiciary reports the following bills to General File: LB 203, LB 670, LB 788, LB 1101, LB 1085; and the following bills with committee amendments attached: LB 875, LB 876, LB 887, LB 943, LB 987, LB 1012, LB 1046, LB 1058, LB 1182, and LB 1207.
