SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Then the question before the body is the adoption of AM3064 to the pending amendment, AM2826. All in favor vote aye, and opposed nay. We're voting on AM3064. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Beutler's amendment to the committee amendments.

SPEAKER BROMM: The amendment is adopted. Next item, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Schrock would move to amend with AM3085. (Legislative Journal page 1058.)

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Schrock, you're recognized to open on your amendment.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, this takes the section out of the bill that deals with refuges. And of course, the issue was the Garden County refuge, and the boundaries. And that bill has been advanced to Select File. It is a consent calendar bill. And being as that has advanced, we do not need that section in this piece of legislation. So I would ask for your adoption of this amendment, which withdraws the game refuge section out of the bill.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Schrock. Senator Erdman.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature. I rise in support of AM3085. The provisions that are being struck are the provisions of LB 826, which is on Select File and consent calendar. And therefore, with that opportunity...that avenue available, it's appropriate for us to remove it out of this proposal. Thank you.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Erdman. There are no further lights. Senator Schrock, do you wish to close on your amendment? He waives closing. The question then is the adoption of AM3085. All in favor please vote aye, and opposed nay. Please record.
