SENATOR SCHROCK: Okay.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But do you think there would be an agreement between the person who is going to have to do more work based on the department's definition of "substantial change," will agree with the department that a substantial change is being made? Or would that person argue that it's a change but it's not substantial?
