Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Madam Chairperson, and I just...while most of the members are still here, I wanted to briefly touch on tomorrow if I could. We'll put the agenda out later, of course, and we'll see where we're at with the budget, but the original plan was to spend some time tomorrow morning on the budget. If the body would decide to move things, we'll back that up with some other bills.
