SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR JENSEN: ...see that we need to do that.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Is there money that is appropriated to them each year by way of that action from the Legislature? Or they automatically get that amount without us having to do anything else?

SENATOR JENSEN: The legislative process approves that every year, the LB 692 dollars, yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And what is the bill in which that approval will be found, if it's to be granted?

SENATOR JENSEN: Well, last year it was LB 407. This year, Senator Byars was...or excuse me, Senator Wehrbein, is that...was that in LB 1089? I think so. I think that's where it was.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: The mainline budget.

SENATOR JENSEN: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Which we moved yesterday.

SENATOR JENSEN: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And they know, who...those who were here, know that amendments were not offered, other than one I offered. But I said there are other areas of that budget that I want to deal with, and that's one of them. I think everybody should take their cuts. I don't care where they get the money from. If they get it as a result of money...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...passing through the hands of the state, they should be cut too. So Creighton, UNMC, and whoever else gets that money, here I come. Thank you, Mr. President.
