CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of committee amendments.

SPEAKER BROMM: The amendments are adopted. Do we have anything else, any other amendments, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: I see no persons wishing to discuss the bill further. Senator Wehrbein, you're recognized to close on the advancement of LB 1092 to E & R Initial.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Thank you. The amendments have become the bill, Mr. Speaker, and I urge their adoption.

SPEAKER BROMM: You've heard the closing. The question is the advancement of LB 1092 to E & R Initial. All in favor vote aye, and opposed nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 1092.

SPEAKER BROMM: LB 1092 is advanced. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 514, a bill by Senator Stuhr. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 17 of last year, at that time referred to the Retirement Systems Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. I do have committee amendments pending, Mr. President. (AM2706, Legislative Journal page 795.)

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Stuhr, you're recognized to open on LB 514.

SENATOR STUHR: Thank you, Mr. President and members of the body. LB 514 concerns the State Patrol Retirement Act and its funding issues. According to the actuarial report issued by the state's actuary in late November, 2003, there is an unfunded
