SENATOR CUDABACK PRESIDING

SENATOR CUDABACK: Good morning. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our acting chaplain this morning is Senator Redfield. Senator Redfield, please.

SENATOR REDFIELD: (Prayer offered.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Redfield, for doing that for us. We appreciate it. Call the forty-seventh day of the Ninety-Eighth Legislature, Second Session, to order. Senators, please check in. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Any corrections for the Journal?

CLERK: No corrections, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: Just one item, Mr. President, LR 277 by Senator Hudkins. The resolution will be laid over, considered another time. That's all that I have. (Legislative Journal pages 1187-1188.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: We thank you, Mr. Clerk. We'll now go to General File, appropriations bills. Mr. Clerk, first bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 1005A by Senator Jensen. (Read title.) I do have an amendment to the bill.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Jensen, to open on LB 1005A.

SENATOR JENSEN: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the Legislature. This LB 1005 was a Health and Human Services kind of cleanup bill. And there are, by the way, there are no General Funds on this. It's strictly Cash Funds. There is appropriated \$38,197 from the Department of Health and Human Services Regulation and Licensure Cash Fund for the 2004-05 budget and \$27,961 from the Department of Health and Human Services Regulation and Licensure Cash Fund for the 2005-06
