Mr. President, bills read on Final Reading on last Thursday were presented to the Governor at 2:31 that afternoon. (Re: LB 454, LB 963, LB 969, LB 172, LB 906, and LB 906A.) I have an amendment to be printed: Senator Louden to LR 11CA. Two new study resolutions: LR 300 and LR 301, by Senator Foley. I'm sorry, these are regular resolutions, LR 300, LR 301; both will be laid over. And I have three Attorney General's Opinions: one to Senator Beutler (re LB 657); one to Senator Mossey (re LB 851); one to Senator Schrock (re LB 1065 and LB 479). And I have an explanation of vote from Senator Stuthman (re LB 172). That's all that I have, Mr. President. (Legislative Journal pages 1279-1313.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. (Visitors and doctor of the day announced.) Now go to General File, appropriation bill. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 826A, by Senator Erdman. (Read title.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Erdman, the motion...to open on the motion, LB 826A.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Thank you, Mr. President. LB 826A is the A bill for LB 826. LB 826 is a bill that's been...that I've introduced and is, I believe, going to be on Final Reading, that deals with the Garden County refuge and other refuges throughout the state. The Game and Parks Commission has said that they could absorb the cost of that proposal; however, the Department of Natural Resources says they could not. The amount is \$8,000. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Erdman. You've heard the opening on LB 826A. Open for discussion on that motion. Senator Erdman, there are no lights on. He waives closing. The question before the body is advancement to E & R Initial, LB 826A. All in favor of the motion vote aye, those opposed nay. We're voting on the advancement of LB 826A to E & R Initial. Have you all voted who wish to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.
