SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Byars, to open on AM3405.

SENATOR BYARS: Yes, Mr. President, a fairly simple amendment. We found out, after the Health and Human Services Department and Legislative Fiscal looked at the amendment that we put on, on General File, that we needed to reinstate some stricken matter, and we needed to clarify "department" in two places to "State Department of Education" and to "the Department of Health and Human Services." And I would answer any questions, but it's fairly simple, and I would move AM3405 to LB 297.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Byars. Open for discussion. Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Mr. President and members of the body, I signed on this amendment, too. I support this. Senator Byars and I have had quite a conversation on this. It does save us significant money. And so I urge your support. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. Any further discussion on the Byars amendment, AM3405? There are no other lights on, Senator Byars. He waives closing. The question before the body is adoption of AM3405, by Senator Byars, to LB 297. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the Byars amendment who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Byars' amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The amendment has been adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on that bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Senator Mossey, for a motion.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 297 to E & R for engrossing.
