at the right point in time. Please, anyone correct me if I'm wrong. There is no other solution offered you that is sufficient in amount of money or that, in fact, answers the problem on the day you're accountable for having answered it. The income tax increase that's been proposed is too little, too slow, and therefore too late. The sales tax increase, in whatever form or permutation, is too little, too slow, too late, and the monies are not available to satisfy the judgment when due, payable, nonappealable, and final, except under AM3477. I don't say that earnestly in the sense that that's going to persuade you to vote for it. I just think we ought to clearly understand what option or options we do or in fact do not have before us. If...I don't want to belabor the point, but I will also tell you that you heard the dialog yesterday with regard to whether we can do something about this 10 percent interest rate. And if anybody wants to go down that path, why, we can start talking about it. But I told you that we would start doing some research. Others of you have been doing some research. It's a fascinating question that maybe only (laugh) somebody who cares about the law would be interested in. But nevertheless, I don't...I would not be overly optimistic. So my reaction is...I'll say it again, because I think it's important in terms of how we, for and on behalf of the people, lead and govern for the people. I don't think we can claim surprise at any future point in time with regard to any of this. And if we come back for a special session in order to stop from being penalized at the rate of \$44,000 per day, it should not be a surprise to anybody, and we ought to have known that we could have done something about it, and we didn't, and we're going to come back then and do it only when we have to, which is sometimes the way that public policy is made. Beyond that, when this methodology for this morning was laid out, I promised that I would not belabor it. So other than answering any of your questions, I'll have nothing further except for closing. But I urge the adoption of AM3477, just on the process of elimination if nothing else. There are no other choices. We can pretend there are. There are no other choices. And maybe our choice, therefore, is to make no choice and do nothing. But then we ought to be honest and accountable for that and say, we're going to do nothing, irrespective of the consequences. With that, I'd urge your adoption of AM3477. Thank you.
