a thorough discussion of what it is he is proposing. Senator Brashear is not presenting something that is illogical in terms of how it is structured. It is simply illogical because it is out of place and out of time at this juncture. This is not an appropriate time and place to adopt an amendment such as that which Senator Brashear is proposing. But I also have to acknowledge that in trying to go through his amendment, I have not been able to put all of the parts together in my mind so that I can say I thoroughly understand it. By taking it a section at a time, it will give Senator Brashear the opportunity to express opposition to the motion that I will have to strike a particular section. Then he is free to range free over all aspects of his bill that he feels need additional elaboration. When he has completed, I believe his bill will go down in flames. But just because that is going to be the outcome does not mean a discussion of what he's talking about is not merited because in the process of discussing his bill, which is doomed, other issues can be raised. Other alternatives can be proposed. And I believe that...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...the further we go and the longer we persist, the better and better an income tax increase is going to look. But being practical, I know the time is not right for that to be attempted yet. But I feel that it's going to come, it's slow. Some of you are moving in that direction already, you just don't know it. Your body is realizing where the truth lies. Your brain knows but you're fighting it. You're drawn to the truth. Well, if he was riding a horse, whatever he on, he got knocked down. And he froze in the air, midway between where he was and the ground. And then he saw the light.
