SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Mossey.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. Speaker, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 1017.

SPEAKER BROMM: Motion is to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 1017. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. The amendments are adopted. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Landis would offer, Mr. President, AM3293. Senator, I have a note I believe earlier that you wanted to withdraw AM3293. Okay.

SPEAKER BROMM: It is withdrawn.

CLERK Mr. President, Senator Combs...oh, that, Senator, I believe was...you had an amendment, but it was to the Landis amendment, so I assume you want to withdraw. Mr. President, Senator Landis, AM3640. (Legislative Journal page 1592.)

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Landis, you're recognized to open on AM3640

SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you. Senator Bromm, members of the Legislature, this being one of the last opportunities to make some adjustments in the revenue sections, there are some minor and, for the most part, technical matters that are contained in this amendment. They are contained in other pieces of legislation, all of which came out of the Revenue Committee unanimously. But, for example, you remember last year that we did the streamline bill, LB 282, and it's a relatively complex piece that is designed to get us to a place where we can collect sales tax on distance sales. There are a number of terms that need to be adjusted in our statutes. For example, Section 11 here uses the term "property" and it's amended to include "or service." Why? Because we have not only sales tax on property sales, but we also have sales tax on services. So we need to say that a couple of times in our statute. We needed to do that in two places. And the sourcing provisions added by LB 1085 are deleted. The amendment would also provide that detective services are deemed to be first used at the residence for an
