SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Pedersen. The motion is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk, LB 1162E.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 1162 on Final Reading.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 1162E pass with the emergency clause attached? All in favor of the motion vote aye; those opposed to the motion vote nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 1636.) The vote is 45 ayes, 0 nays, 4 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 1162E passes with the emergency clause attached. Mr. Clerk, LB 1231.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 1231 on Final Reading.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 1231 pass? All in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed to the motion vote nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 1636.) The vote is 49 ayes, 0 nays, 0 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 1231 passes. Mr. Clerk, LB 1231A, when you get time.
