8 (35) Utility trailer license plates issued pursuant to

10 (36) Well-boring apparatus and well-servicing equipment
11 license plates issued pursuant to section 60-3,109.

12 Sec. 3. (1) Any resident of this state who is the owner
13 of a motor vehicle or trailer required to be registered in this
14 state may apply for and obtain thirty-day license plates which
15 allow such person to operate such motor vehicle or tow such trailer
16 on the highways of this state while in Nebraska on leave from
17 military service.

18 (2) An application for such thirty-day license plates
19 shall be made to the county treasurer or designated county official
20 of the county in which such motor vehicle or trailer has situs.
21 The license plates shall be valid for a period of thirty days and
22 shall be attached in the same manner as regular license plates.
23 The fees and taxes shall be equivalent to one-twelfth of the
24 annual registration fee, motor vehicle fee, and motor vehicle taxes
25 for the type of motor vehicle or trailer being registered. Such
26 fees and taxes shall be collected and distributed in the same
27 manner as other motor vehicle fees and taxes. Upon receipt of such

1 application, presentation of military orders showing his or her
2 temporary leave status, and payment of the fees and taxes, the
3 county treasurer or designated county official shall issue such
4 license plates to such applicant.

5 (3) Thirty-day license plates issued under this section
6 shall be the same size and of the same basic design as regular
7 license plates issued pursuant to section 60-3,100. The department
8 shall design the plates.

9 (4) The application shall include an affidavit that the
10 motor vehicle or trailer is not being operated or towed on the
11 highways of this state during any other portion of the registration
12 period. A person who is cited for a violation of section 60-362
13 shall not be eligible for thirty-day license plates under this
14 section for one year after the issuance of the citation.

15 Sec. 5. Section 60-3,165, Revised Statutes Supplement,
16 2005, is amended to read:

17 60-3,165 If a citation is issued to an owner or operator
18 of a motor vehicle or trailer for a violation of section 60-362
19 and the owner properly registers and licenses the motor vehicle
20 or trailer not in compliance and pays all taxes and fees due
21 and the owner or operator provides proof of such registration to
22 the prosecuting attorney within ten days after the issuance of
23 the citation, no prosecution for the offense cited shall occur. A
24 person issued such a citation shall not be eligible for thirty-day
25 license plates under section 3 of this act for one year after the
26 issuance of such citation.
